Dr. Celli's newest responsibility is the care of the inhabitants of the Calgary Zoo's new Land of Lemurs habitat, which is home to black-and-white ruffed lemurs, red fronted lemurs, and ring-tailed lemurs. Join us for a conversation with these two celebrated conservationists as they discuss the current plight of the lemurs of Madagascar and role the Calgary Zoo has taken upon itself to help conserve the environment and protect these endangered species.
