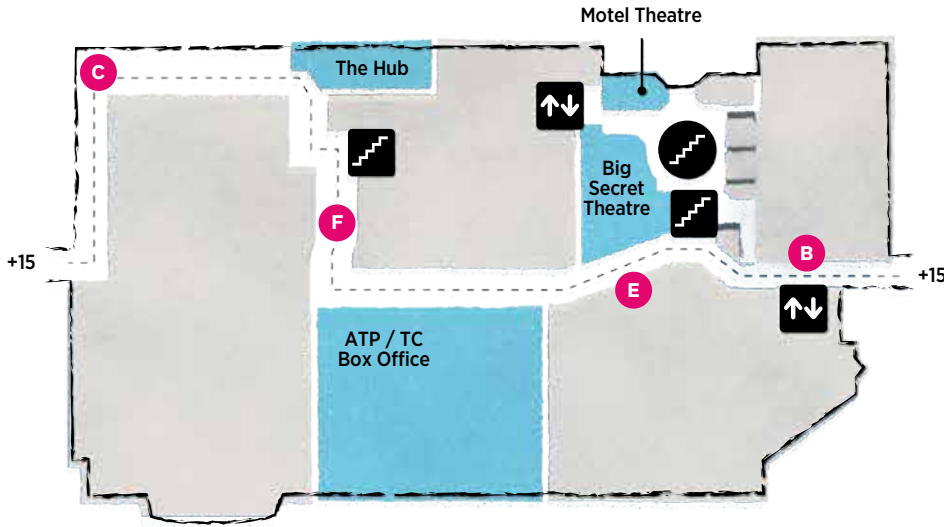
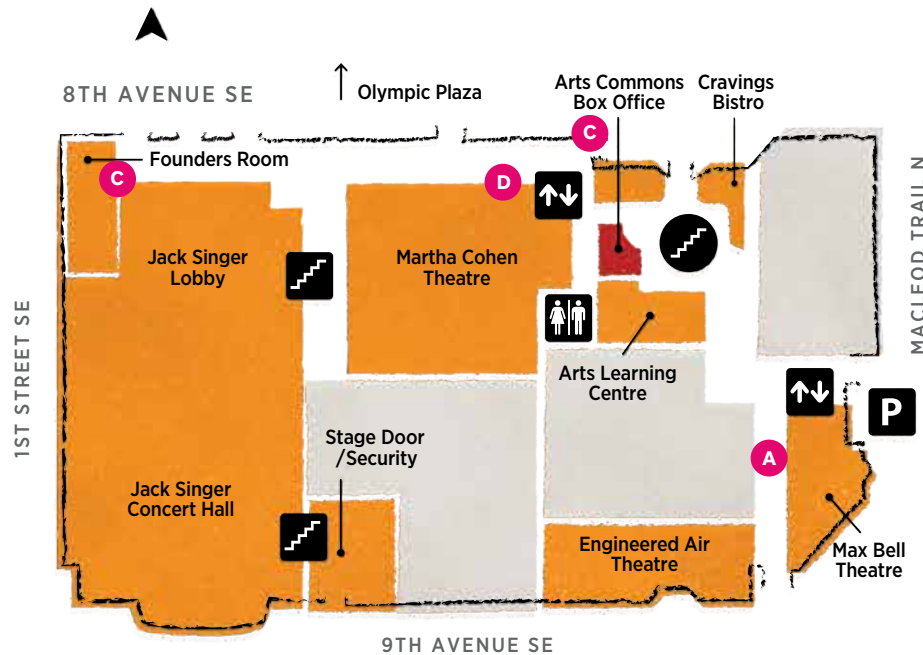

ARTS COMMONS | MAIN LEVEL

Since 2006, Arts Commons has been growing our investment in Calgary's visual arts community. Today we curate the **Lightbox Studio, Ledge Gallery, Window Galleries**, and eight **+15 Galleries** through the RBC Emerging Visual Artists Program as well as media installations in **Broadcast Lab** and **+15 Soundscape**.

Our galleries feature both local and national emerging visual artists and community partners. Exhibitions rotate every three months and are open to an audience of over 600,000 annually.

A WINDOW GALLERIES

These seven display spaces in the hall adjacent to the Max Bell Theatre are used as exhibition opportunities for both two-dimensional and sculptural works created by local emerging artists and collectives.

D LIGHTBOX STUDIO

Located beside Martha Cohen Theatre on the Main Level, Lightbox Studio is an experimental studio and exhibition space that promotes studio-based projects.

B LEDGE GALLERY

The largest gallery space in Arts Commons, Ledge Gallery is located on the +15 Level just above the Mezzanine. There you'll find new installations, as well as performative and sculptural works.

E +15 SOUNDSCAPE

Overlooking the scene shop and located near Theatre Calgary and Alberta Theatre Projects' administrative offices on the +15 Level, the +15 Soundscape is a multichannel sound system that provides opportunities to local and national sound artists.

C BROADCAST LAB

Arts Commons provides screening space for media artists to showcase experimental film, video art, animations, and short documentaries, on three separate media monitors throughout the building.

F +15 GALLERIES

Our eight +15 Galleries provide a unique exhibition opportunity for community driven projects featuring emerging artists and curators. These galleries are located on the +15 Level adjacent to the Jack Singer Concert Hall.
