## The Slide Guitar Chops of Jack Broadbent Brings the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Season of PCL Blues to a Rocking Close with Arts Commons Presents

March 21, 2023 - CALGARY – Returning to Calgary by popular demand, Jack Broadbent performs his newest album Ride in the intimate venue of the Engineered Air Theatre. "His most rugged and powerful performance to date," (Holler Country) Ride takes you on a road trip through a vibrant mix of blues, alternative rock, Americana, and folk with one of the best slide guitarists in the business. Join Arts Commons Presents and experience Jack Broadbent live as part of the PCL Blues series from Arts Commons Presents on Friday, April 14 & Saturday, April 15, 2023.

Last in Calgary for his sold-out 2017 performance as part of the PCL Blues series, Jack Broadbent is a viral star who has proven that he can go the distance with each new release. His rise to internet fame came in 2014 while he was busking in Amsterdam and a passerby posted a recording of his performance to YouTube. The video clocked over 327,000 views as the wider world marveled at Broadbent's singular self-taught slide-guitar talent. From there he has only gotten bigger and better, releasing six albums as well as opening for names like Ronnie Wood of The Rolling Stones, Peter Frampton, Lynyrd Skynyrd, and Tony Joe White. Critics who saw his appearance at the 2016 Montreux Jazz Festival called him "the new master of the slide guitar."

With Ride, Broadbent has a few more surprises up his sleeve. Recorded in Quebec during the height of the pandemic, the album transformed into a fully formed slide guitar tribute to rock'n'roll rather than Broadbent's originally envisioned acoustic album. Fortunately, critics couldn't be happier, praising, "Jack Broadbent demonstrates once again his remarkable and almost unrivalled talent on the slide guitar" (Louderthanwar) and "a simmering, spicy jambalaya of boogie, rock, and blues" (Rock & Blues Muse).

"We started playing some of the more rock 'n' roll stuff I had, and we couldn't deny that there was a kind of vibe happening. We built on those grooves and ended up with the rock 'n' roll record I've been wanting to make for a long time," says Broadbent. *"I feel like this album is the best work I've done. For me, writing songs in different styles and not being afraid of casting a wide net is certainly a great advantage for improving your writing—it means eventually you have a boundary-less landscape to work with."* 

Nearing the finale of its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary season, the PCL Blues series is testament to Calgary's love affair with the blues genre. The 2022-23 season of the PCL Blues series has celebrated GRAMMY Award-winning superstars to homegrown favourites and everything in between, demonstrating the remarkable diversity of the genre.

"The 22-23 season has really showcased the wide variety that the Blues genre can encompass," says Stephanie Hutchinson, Associate Director, Programming at Arts Commons. "From returning favourites, to masters of their instruments, and powerful vocalists, we couldn't be prouder of our 25th Anniversary lineup!"
