## Ruben Studdard and Clay Aiken Celebrate Twenty Years of *American Idol* at the Jack Singer Concert Hall with Arts Commons Presents

August 8, 2023 - CALGARY – Arts Commons Presents kicks off the 2023-24 season of star-studded performances with two of the most beloved *American Idol* contestants ever – Ruben Studdard and Clay Aiken. This special presentation launches the Canadian leg of *Twenty | The Tour* in Calgary, celebrating 20 years since their memorable television appearance and the beginning of their enduring friendship. Taking the second season of *American Idol* by storm, this irresistible duo made for ratings gold, nearly tripling the viewership from the previous season. With over 38 million viewers casting more than 124 million votes, their nail-biting finale remains the most watched *American Idol* episode in history. Studdard took home first prize, with Aiken as a very close runner-up, but despite being competitors on screen, Studdard and Aiken struck up an immediate friendship. They have brought this friendship to the stage, performing frequently together over the course of their 20-year career.

In Aiken’s words, *“We don’t get to choose our family. Most family is predetermined by blood; some are predestined by God to come into our lives. I’ve got one brother who was born into my family and one brother who the good Lord introduced me to in 2003.”*

Since their now iconic television finale, they’ve taken their vocal talent around the globe and continue to demonstrate the star power that it took to win the hearts of millions of fans. Together they have toured the United States 14 times, starred together on Broadway, and sold more than eight million albums worldwide. Studdard has been nominated for two GRAMMY Awards, and won two Billboard Music Awards, among other accolades. Aiken has brought home five Billboard Music Awards and made numerous television appearances including *30 Rock*, *Law & Order: Special Victims Unit*, and *Are You Smarter Than a 5<sup>th</sup> Grader?*

Together Ruben Studdard and Clay Aiken make a pitch-perfect duo of undeniable talent. They have been praised for “show-stopping performances” (The Columbus Dispatch) that are “truly something special,” (Nippertown). Their concert in Calgary is the first of only two Canadian dates on their North American tour.
