Arts Commons Presents Welcomes Icon Booker T. Jones for a Revue of Greatest Blues, Soul, and R&B Hits from Stax Records

This once-in-a-lifetime chance to see the jazz legend live in Calgary performing highlights from music recording history caps off Black History Month on February 25 with Arts Commons Presents

February 8, 2023 - CALGARY – Celebrated musician and front man of Booker T. & the M.G.'s Booker T. Jones brings his career –retrospective production, Booker T: A Stax Revue, to Calgary for an evening of genre-defining blues, soul, and R&B. Join Arts Commons Presents for Booker T: A Stax Revue and hear some of the greatest hits of the last century performed live as part of our Jazz series in the Jack Singer Concert Hall on February 25, 2023.

Inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1992 and a Lifetime Achievement GRAMMY Award winner, Booker T. Jones's career has been nothing short of extraordinary. The New York Times observes that "No living musician is more closely associated than Booker T. Jones with Memphis, the Mississippi River city that fostered a world-changing generation of blues, gospel and soul music five decades ago." And the BBC remarks that "Few have done so much for soul music as Booker T. Jones." A prolific songwriter, master of the Hammond B-3 organ, and celebrated producer, he was instrumental in shaping the Stax Records sound. Second only to Motown Records, Stax Records had an essential role in the creation of Southern soul and Memphis soul music. Throughout the 1960s, Booker T. and the M.G.'s were the house band for nearly every recording made by the studio including backing albums by Otis Redding, William Bell, Albert King, and the Mad Lads among many others.

Along with their support of so many big-name artists, Booker T. and the M.G.'s are acclaimed in their own right with hits like *Respect*, *Try a Little Tenderness*, and *Green Onions*, which will be performed as part of his appearance at the Jack Singer Concert Hall. In addition to the songs immediately associated with Booker T., the audience can expect to hear deep cuts like the brassy *Mr. Big Stuff* and sinisterly funky *Born Under a Bad Sign*.

Jones admits that choosing the setlist for his shows is a challenge. "The more I live, the more music I become involved in, the more music I love and like, the more music I want to share with the audience," he says. "There's so much music in my past that I really love and really want to share."

Booker T. Jones comes to Calgary with Booker T: *A Stax Revue*, a musical tour through the history of Stax Records that showcases Jones' greatest hits. Featuring a ten-piece big band with three lead vocalists, a three-piece horn section, and a rhythm section to provide a funky backbeat, Jones will present an energetic retrospective of the songs that made him a household name while regaling the audience with personal anecdotes that offer a glimpse behind the music. Booker T: *A Stax Revue* will transform Calgary into Memphis North as this legend of soul brings down the house in the Jack Singer Concert Hall.
