Founded in 2011 by Daveed Goldman and Nobu Adilman, Choir! Choir! Choir! redefines the concert experience by flipping our expectations of what a live show should be and who it's for. The premise is simple: Goldman and Adilman select a well-known song from the modern music catalogue and walk the audience step-by-step through a custom choral arrangement, culminating in an explosive performance that puts the audience front-and-centre for an incredible finale of their own making.

From their humble origins in the Toronto bar scene, charging five bucks for a song sheet, Choir! Choir! Choir! has since achieved widespread recognition for their unorthodox approach to the modern concert experience, and participants have ballooned from a dozen singers in a bar to thousands of singers at a time. There are no auditions, and everyone is welcome. The duo has performed with renowned artists such as Patti Smith, David Byrne, Tegan and Sara, and Rufus Wainwright, and has appeared onstage at New York's Carnegie Hall and Radio City Music Hall. Their videos have gone viral with millions of views, including a surprise appearance by Rick Astley.

Choir! Choir! Choir! gives anyone and everyone who loves to sing, regardless of skill level or experience, a chance to perform in a world class venue designed to celebrate the power of music. It's an energizing, massive sing-along that Arts Commons Presents is proud to share with our community. Now, more than ever, people are craving these types of experiences as we adjust to a post-COVID reality. The Globe and Mail calls them "a feel good and viral sensation" and The New Yorker says that the duo "has fashioned a profound way for people to connect and interact."

"Every single time we go out there, we're looking to make a connection with people-to make people feel like they came to the right place and that they can carry that forward. A critical number of people have shown us or told us that what we're doing is important to them and that keeps us going," says Nobu Adilman.
