Ólafur Arnalds says, "I was focused on trying to be really free, to not overthink things, to not layer too many things, to not get stuck in grand ideas. Just making music in a way that feels pure. It's definitely a little bit back-to-basics for me. Instead of adding layers upon layers to create something big, I would spend days on a tiny thing. Trying to shape it into something that speaks volumes with just a few notes."

Ólafur's deeply reflective musical meditations have thrived in an era of digital media. In 2015, Ólafur made his television scoring debut with the hit TV series *Broadchurch*, which gave the perfect setting for his haunting and often melancholic compositions and won him a BAFTA award. In 2018, his album re:member changing the playing field once again by debuting his self-playing Stratus pianos which have since become a feature of his live concerts. This unique way of performing means that no two performances are the same, as each keystroke offers a novel reshaping of each piece. His remarkable flexibility as an artist is reflected in his recent nomination in two categories – Best Dance Recording and Best Arrangement, Instruments And Vocals — at the 2022 GRAMMY Awards for the EP Loom, described as a "tender serenity of sparkling, atmospheric melodies ebbing and flowing" (The Playground).
